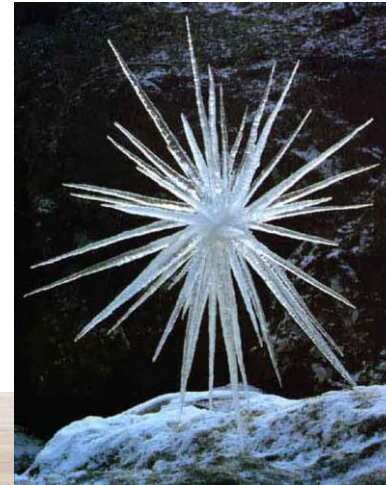


Natural Art
