These are examples of some of the supports we may choose to offer you/your child. The support we offer is judged on an individual basis.

- Targeted pre-learning sessions to help develop pupil's knowledge of topics
- Book and reading clubs to develop language and vocabulary
- Teaching assistant buddies paired with families to offer greater channels of communication
- Extra catch up meetings with teachers and other school staff to discuss children's needs.
- Parent workshops and coffee mornings
- Support with school trips
- Guidance on how to support pupils with their learning – information booklets and videos
- Support to attend a variety of extra-curricular activities
- Targeted clubs e.g. Homework Club, Movement Club
- Targeted support and interventions of reading, writing and maths
- Emotional and social support
- Signposting to other professional organisations (e.g. Family Support worker, Emotional Health Academy, Department of Work and Pensions, charities, etc.)
